Beside your name on the return address please add your PAAI membership number. If the PAAI membership number is not added to the return address your vote will NOT count. All membership numbers will be checked against a master list to verify your vote. The unmarked white envelope containing your ballot will be placed in a box and later counted by the elections committee to insure your secret ballot.
